UWNYC's Health Equity Cabinet will convene industry experts, medical professionals, and advocates to develop innovative strategies for addressing health disparities and influencing policy

In 2020-2023, UWNYC successfully incubated Choose Healthy Life, a national non-profit addressing health disparities by partnering with Black churches. Now, UWNYC's Health Equity team is a NYC hub for affiliated churches, while leading nationwide data management and training initiatives.



CONNECT2CARE

Connect2Care is a partnership with NYC community-based organizations to enhance their capacity for health equity work. The program also provides health services and screenings for social determinants of health through public events in low-income communities.

UWNYC, in partnership with mobile health provider VIP StarNETWORK and the New York State Department of Health, delivers pop-up preventative care programs and comprehensive medical screenings with community-based organizations.
